

### You may be eligible for need-based financial aid through the University of Toronto Advanced Planning for Students (UTAPS) program, if you are:

- A Canadian citizen, or a permanent resident, or a protected person (recognized convention refugee), or an individual registered under the *Indian Act* (Canada); and
- Enrolled at the University of Toronto Scarborough campus in an undergraduate program; and
- Registered in a full-time course load (per the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) requirements) for the <u>entire May to August summer session</u>, and not enrolled in a co-op work term; **and**
- Receiving need-based grant/loan assistance from:
  - o A Canadian province/territory other than Ontario, or
  - First Nations band funding through the Post-Secondary Student Support Program, or
  - Inuit or Métis Nation funding through the Post-Secondary Education Support Program; and
- Assessed as having unmet need based on the OSAP financial need assessment.

#### Required steps to be assessed for UTAPS:

- Review and confirm the accuracy of your mailing address and direct deposit information on ACORN. Ensure the dates for this information remain valid and have not expired.
- Complete this six-page UTAPS Application.
- Submit the completed UTAPS Application and the required documentation by Monday, June 16, 2025, via the OOP Request Portal (<a href="https://www3.adm.utoronto.ca/oop/index.php">https://www3.adm.utoronto.ca/oop/index.php</a>).
  - Make sure to select "UTSC Summer UTAPS Application" from the Form Request Type drop-down menu.

#### Required Documentation:

- A copy of your 2025 Summer Government Student Aid Loan/Grants
  Assistance Summary from your Canadian province/territory funding program;
  or,
- A copy of your funding letter from your First Nations band, or Inuit or Métis Nation organization.

This document **must be submitted** for your UTAPS Application to be processed and for your financial need to be determined.
